We welcome you to our website. We would like to inform you about the management of your personal data in accordance with Art. 13 General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

CONTROLLER

USAGE DATA

When you visit our website, the data collected from the use of the website is temporarily stored on our web server for statistical purposes in order to improve the quality of our website. This data set contains:

- the page, from which the data is requested
- the name of the data file,
- the date and time of the query,
- the amount of data transferred,
- the access status (file transmitted, file not found),
- a description of the type of browser used,
- the IP address of the requesting computer shortened to such an extent that no identification of any persona data is possible.

The listed usage data is stored anonymously.

LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

We process your personal data when necessary to fulfill our legitimate interests, such as ensuring the proper functioning of our website and in order to take steps prior to entering into a contract by responding to your requests for information about our business, products or services.

USE OF COOKIES

We use cookies for our website. Cookies are small pieces of data that are stored and read in your end-device. A distinction is made between session cookies, which are deleted when you close your browser, and persistent cookies, which are stored even after your visit has expired. Cookies may contain data that enables the recognition of the device being used. However, in some cases cookies only contain information on certain settings which are not personal data.

We use persistent cookies to customize your visits to the site, remember your preferences on the site, track usage patterns on the site, or analyze activity online. For instance, we use cookies to tell us whether you have visited the site before or if you are a new visitor and to help us identify features of the site in which you may have the greatest interest. The data is processed in accordance to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR and in the interest of optimizing or enabling user guidance.

Please be aware that you can set your browser to inform you when cookies are being stored or used on the website you are visiting. Thus, any use of cookies is transparent to you. You have the possibility to delete your browser configuration at any time and

prevent any use of new cookies. In the event you refuse the use of cookies, please note that our web sites may not be displayed optimally and some functions are then no longer technically available.

TRACKINGTOOLS

We do not use tracking tools.

DATA TRANSFER TO THIRD PARTIES

Personal data we collect may be stored on servers, databases and with third parties in the United States and other countries whose data protection laws may differ from the jurisdiction in which you live. When we transfer personal data from the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland to other countries outside the EEA or Switzerland, we rely on the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield or the Swiss-U.S. Privacy Shield or other approved data transfer mechanisms, which may be requested by contacting us at Compliance.Officer@viskase.com.

THIRD-PARTY ANALYTICS

Our Sites use a third-party analytics service, Google Analytics, to collect information about the use of our Sites, compile reports on activity, analyze performance metrics, and collect and evaluate other information related to the Sites. Google Analytics is a web analytics services provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics places cookies on your computer to collect information about use of the Sites. The information that Google collects, including your IP address, will be transmitted to and stored on servers in the United States. Google will not associate your IP address with other information held by Google. By using the Sites, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above. DATA PROCESSORS

We transfer your data to service providers who support us in the operation of our website and the associated processes. This transference is made under the scope of a data processing agreement in accordance to Art. 28 GDPR. Our service providers are bound to us by strict instructions and contractual obligations.

YOUR RIGHTS AS A USER

As a website user, the GDPR grants you certain rights when processing your personal data.

1. Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR):

You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you is being processed, and, where that is the case access to the personal data and the information specified in Art. 15 GDPR.

2. Right to rectification and erasure (Art. 16 and 17 GDPR):

You have the right to obtain without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and, if necessary, the right to have incomplete person-al data completed.

You also have the right to obtain an erasure of the personal data concerning you without undue delay, if one of the reasons listed in Art. 17 GDPR applies, e.g. if the data is no longer necessary for the intended purpose.

3. Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR):

If one of the conditions set forth in Art. 18 GDPR applies, you shall have the right to restrict the processing of your data to mere storage, e.g. if you revoke consent, to the processing, for the duration of a possible examination.

4. Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR):

In certain situations, listed in Art. 20 GDPR, you have the right to receive the personal data concerning you in a structured, common and machine-readable format or demand a transmission of the data to another third party.

5. Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR):

If the data is processed pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR (data processing for the purposes of the legitimate interests), you have the right to object to the processing at any time for reasons arising out of your particular situation. We will then no longer process personal data, unless there are demonstrably compelling legitimate grounds for processing, which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the person concerned, or the processing serves the purpose of asserting, exercising or defending legal claims.

6. Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

Pursuant to Art. 77 GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you consider the processing of the data concerning you infringes data protection regulations. The right to lodge a complaint may be invoked in particular in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or the place of the alleged infringement.
